


How to downgrade iPhone 4S / iPad 2 to iOS 6.1.3

Now V2.17 3uTools supports downgrading iPhone...



INTRODUCTION

Now V2.17 3uTools supports downgrading iPhone 4s and iPad 2 to iOS 6.1.3 after jailbreak without SHSH.

Step 1 — Enter kDFU mode




 Launch Cydia and add repo: http://repo.tihmstar.net
to enter
KDFU mode (Please check the
detailed tutorial). Only when your
iDevice is in KDFU mode, you
can downgrade to iOS 6.1.3.
Please make sure your iDevice is
in KDFU mode, then continue to
downgrade.

Step 2 — Download custom firmware.




 Download the corresponding custom firmware for your iDevice; http://www.3u.com/tutorial/articles/4207...

Step 3 — 3uTools proflash




Launch 3uTools and go to "Flash & JB" -> "Pro Flash", click "Import Firmware" and select the firmware you have already downgraded.

Step 4 — Go "Flash"



 After you import the firmware, click "Flash" on the right bar.

Step 5 — Wait till the process is finished



 Now 3uTools will automatically flash your iDevice, please confirm the connection between your iDevice and pc.

Step 6 — Finish



Normally, it would take around 10 minutes to downgrade.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
