




HP Officejet Pro 6835 Sensor Chip Replacement

Replace the sensor chip inside of an HP Officejet Pro 6835.

INTRODUCTION

The sensor chip is a small, green chip located in the top-right corner inside printer. It is held in by a small screw.

Step 1 — HP Officejet Pro 6835 Cover Disassembly



- Open the main lid as far as it will go.
- Use a plastic opening tool to gently pry off the hinge on the right side by pushing it to the left and off the hook.
- Open the lid further.


Step 2



- Use a T9 torx screwdriver to remove a total of ten (10) 12mm screws from the main cover by turning the screwdriver counterclockwise.

i The two screws above the screen assembly are deep so you may need a long screwdriver.


Step 3



- Grab the main cover and lift it up slightly.

 Do not pull too hard—there is a cable connecting the cover to the printer.

Step 4



- Grab the base of the white ribbon cable connecting the cover to the base of the printer and pull it out.
