


# Motorola Moto G5 Motherboard Replacement

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide will help with the replacement of a broken or faulty motherboard.

Before you begin, download the <u>Rescue and Smart Assistant</u> app to backup your device and diagnose whether your problem is software or hardware related.

## 🖌 TOOLS:

Spudger (1) iFixit Opening Tool (1) Tweezers (1) Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Back Cover



- Insert your fingernail or the flat end of a spudger into the notch on the bottom edge of the phone near the charging port.
- Pry with your fingernail or twist the spudger to release the back cover from the phone.



• Insert the flat end of a spudger into the seam and slide it along the bottom edge to release the clips holding the back cover to the phone.

#### Step 3



• Continue sliding the flat end of the spudger along the seam for the remaining sides of the phone.



- Lift the back cover and remove it from the phone.
- To reinstall the back cover, align the cover with the phone and squeeze along the edges to snap the clips back into place.

#### Step 5 — Battery



- Insert your fingernail or the flat end of the spudger into the notch below the battery.
- Pry with your fingernail or spudger until you free the battery from its recess.



- Remove the battery.
- When installing the battery, make sure the battery's contacts line up with the three gold pins on the top right.

#### Step 7 — Rear Facing Camera



• Remove the eight (8) 4mm screws with a Phillips screwdriver.



- Pry the top motherboard cover off using a plastic opening tool.
- (i) When prying it open, make sure to pry it around evenly so that the cover will not snap. This will require some force.

#### Step 9




• Disconnect the marked connector with a pair of <u>tweezers</u> and remove the camera piece.

## Step 10 — Motherboard




 Remove the two 4mm screws shown in the picture using a Phillips #00 screwdriver.

## Step 11



• Lift the motherboard up from the top of the phone.



 Unplug the back connector from the motherboard using <u>tweezers</u>.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
