INTRODUCTION

Is the RAM in your Dell Inspiron 15-3543 defective or full? If so, here is the guide to fix the problem by simply replacing your RAM. All you need is the standard #0 Phillips Screwdriver head in order to remove the one screw involved with this replacement.



TOOLS:

Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — RAM





 Using a #0 Phillips screwdriver, remove the 2.0mm screw from the back of the device beside the vents.

Step 2









 Slide the panel off by placing your hands on top and, while using a little force, sliding your hands down.

Step 3







- Using two fingers, slide the two notches holding the RAM in place outwards.
- After the notches are moved outwards, the RAM will pop up and it can be pulled out.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
