
INTRODUCTION

Step 1 — Remove the Screws




- Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.

Step 2 — Lifting the Latch




- Lift the latch and disconnect the hard-drive cable from the system board.

Step 3 — Lifting the Hard-Drive Assembly




- Lift the hard-drive assembly off the computer base.

Step 4 — Disconnecting the Interposer




- Disconnect the interposer from the hard drive.

Step 5 — Remove the Screws




- Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive and lift the hard-drive bracket off the hard drive.

Step 6 — Placing the Hard-Drive Bracket



- Place the hard-drive bracket over the **NEW** hard drive and align the screw holes on the hard-drive bracket with the screw holes on the hard drive.

Step 7 — Replace the Screws





- Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 8 — Sliding the Hard-Drive Assembly




- Slide the hard-drive assembly in the computer base and align the screw holes on the hard-drive assembly with the screw holes on the computer base.

Step 9 — Slide the Hard-Drive Cable



- Slide the hard-drive cable into its connector and close the latch to secure the cable.

Step 10 — Replace the Screws



- Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.
