INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace a missing or broken knob with glue.

TOOLS:

Large Needle Nose Pliers (1)

Polyurethane Glue (1)

Step 1 — Knob



- If a knob falls off, make sure metal tab is still in place.
- If not, insert metal tab into horizontal slot with pliers.

Step 2



- Apply polyurethane glue to the inside of the metal tab.

Step 3



- Attach the knob to the slot in its original position.

⚠ Allow glue to fully dry before using knob.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
