


# How to reset the SMC, PRAM and NVRAM on a MacBook Pro Touch Bar 2018

MacBook Pro acting up? These resets may be able to solve your MacBook Pro issues! This procedure also works for the 15" model too.

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## **INTRODUCTION**

I had to make a separate guide for this particular MacBook Pro as it has the new Apple T2 Chip and requires a different procedure then the other Mac Laptops.

### Step 1 — SMC Reset Part 1



- Choose Apple menu > Shut Down.
- After your Mac shuts down, press and hold its power button for 10 seconds.
- Release the power button, then wait a few seconds.
- Press the power button again to turn on your Mac.
- if these procedures do not fix the problem, move onto Step 2.

#### Step 2 — SMC Reset part 2



- Choose Apple menu > Shut Down.
- After your Mac shuts down, press and hold the left Shift key, the left Option key, and the left Control key for 7 seconds. Then keep holding those keys while you press and hold the power button for another 7 seconds.
- Release all three keys and the power button, then wait a few seconds.
- Press the power button again to turn on your Mac.

### Step 3 — PRAM/NVRAM Reset



- Shut down your Mac.
- Then turn it on and immediately press and hold these four keys together: Option, Command, P, and R.
- You can release the keys after about 20 seconds, during which your Mac might appear to restart.
- You can release the keys after the Apple logo appears and disappears for the second time, or after 20 seconds. Whichever comes first.
