

Toro Lawn Mower Cutting Blade Replacement

This guide will help to accomplish the replacement of the blade on a Toro Lawn Mower to ensure that the unit is cutting grass effectively.

INTRODUCTION

Replacing the cutting blade on a lawn mower is important to ensure that your grass is cut correctly and that your lawn mower is running efficiently. This is a simple fix that requires little to no expertise or previous experience. Just make sure to be careful when handling the blade itself and all should run smoothly.

TOOLS:

- 5/8" Wrench (1)
- 5/8" Socket (1)
- Leather Work Gloves (1)
- Wooden Chock (1)

PARTS:


• Toro Lawn Mower Blade (1)

Step 1 — Cutting Blade



 Disconnect the spark plug to ensure that the lawn mower does not accidentally turn over and cause the mower to turn on.

Step 2



• Flip the mower onto its side exposing the blade and under carriage.

Step 3



 Place wood in between the blade and the wall of the mower to ensure that the blade does not move while you are tightening or loosening the bolt.

Step 4



- Using the 5/8 wrench, turn the blade counter clockwise until the bolt is loose then pull the blade off.
- (i) Make sure that safety gloves are worn at all times when handling the new or old cutting blade.

Step 5



- Place the new blade in right side up into the bracket and line up the bolt.
- (i) Make sure that safety gloves are being worn at all times when handling either the new or old cutting blade.

Step 6



• Using the 5/8 ratchet, turn the bolt clockwise until the bolt does not turn anymore.

Step 7



• Flip the mower right-side up and reconnect the spark plug.

This simple fix should help make the lawn mower function efficiently and safely for years to come.
