


Sony Vaio SVE151G11L Speaker Replacement

This is a comprehensive guide for replacing the internal speakers of the Sony Vaio SVE151G11L laptop.

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INTRODUCTION

The speakers allow the laptop to play sounds such as music. This guide shows the steps to remove the speakers for repair or replacement.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery



 Turn the laptop over so its underside is facing upwards and visible.

Step 2



 Standing so that the barcode and warning labels are upright and legible, push the left tab up and away from yourself.



 Standing so that the barcode and warning labels are upright and legible, push the **right tab** up and away from yourself.

Step 4



 Locate the small gap where the battery and the laptop shell meet.
Lift from the gap and rotate the battery up and away from yourself.



Pull battery away from laptop.

Step 6 — Hard Disk Drive



 Flip laptop over so the bottom is facing upwards.



 Remove 2 bottom screws in the top right on the HDD cover, with a size P000 screwdriver.

Step 8





Pop open the cover to the HDD.



 Remove the screws on the HDD with a Phillips #000 screwdriver.

Step 10





- Pull plastic tab away from the laptop.
- Lift HDD away from laptop.

Step 11 — Speakers










Remove the back cover.

Step 12






Remove 4 hinge screws with a Phillips #0 screwdriver.









- Pop open hinge.
- Remove black screw size P000.

Step 14





Remove wiring along its guide.







- Remove two hinge screws size P00.
- Pop open hinge.


Step 16





Remove black screw.







Remove secondary black screw.

Step 18




Remove speaker.





- Follow wire down its wire channel and remove it from the channel.
- Pull up on the connector to disconnect the speakers to the motherboard.

Step 20



 Remove speaker and wire from the laptop. To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
