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INTRODUCTION

How to remove and replace the HDD on an HP ProBook 440 G1.



TOOLS:

• Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)



PARTS:

- 1 TB SSD (1)
- 250 GB SSD (1)
- Crucial MX500 500 GB SSD (1)
- Crucial MX500 2 TB SSD (1)

Step 1 — Battery





- ↑ Make sure the laptop is turned off before you start.
- Push and hold the release tab on the right and left toward the center.

Step 2





Pull the battery out.

Step 3 — Backplate








Push and hold the release tabs on the right and left toward the center again.

Step 4



Slide the backplate off.

Step 5 — Hard Disc Drive (HDD)





Locate the hard drive, opposite the battery across from the wireless card.

Step 6







• Remove all four Phillips #00 screws that hold the hard drive in place.

Step 7







- Lift up on the outer part of the hard drive.
- Pull the hard drive out.

Step 8





- Remove the four Phillips #00 screws holding the HDD in the HDD cover.
- The HDD should slide out after all screws are removed.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
