


# **TI-84 Plus Disassembly**

- TR6 Torx Security Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)
- iFixit Opening Picks (Set of 6) (1)

## Step 1 — flip





- (i) Be sure the calculator is powered off before proceeding.
- Take off the sliding cover, and flip your calculator to the back side.

#### Step 2 — battery plate.





Press down on the latch, then remove the battery cover.


#### Step 3 — take out the batteries





- Remove the batteries.
- You can use the battery cover as a plate to keep the batteries.

## Step 4 — back up battery







- Removing this battery will clear your RAM, so be sure that you have made any backups of important data.
- Use a Phillips #0 to remove the plate from the back up battery.

#### Step 5 — backup battery





• remove the backup battery with either a screwdriver or the spudger.

#### Step 6



 you can use a t6 or tr6 take out all six marked screws

#### Step 7 — cracking the case







• Use a prying tool to get a pick into the side and then move it down until its open.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
