This guide will repair any shoe that has a hole in the bottom on the sole or is ripped on the bottom.

TOOLS:

- [Barge Cement Infinity Glue](#) (1)
- [Knife or key](#) (1)



PARTS:

- [new shoe sole](#) (1)

Step 1 — Sole



- Place shoe upside down.

Step 2



- Wedge knife or key into the area where the shoe and sole meet.

Step 3



- Peel the sole off of the bottom of the shoe.

Step 4



- Wipe away any dirt or residue on the bottom. does not have to be spotless.

Step 5



- Place shoe glue on the bottom of the shoe.

Step 6



- align the sole with the shoe perfectly and press them together. Allow to sit for at least a day before testing them out.

The shoe will be as good as new, if you don't allow to dry long enough just retry the steps 4 through 6.
