


# Lenovo YOGA 730-15IKB Left Fan Replacement

This guide describes the steps required to replace the left fan on a Lenovo YOGA 730-15IKB.

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#### INTRODUCTION

Follow this guide to replace or remove the *left* fan in your Lenovo YOGA 730-15IKB. The fans in a laptop draw air over the components which allows them to stay cool and last longer.

If your fans are noisy or create a high-pitched whining noise, they may need to be replaced. You can also try blowing compressed air into the fan to remove any built-up dust that may be slowing it down.



#### **TOOLS:**

- T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- ESD Safe Tweezers Blunt Nose (1)



PARTS:
Lenovo Yoga 730 (15") Left Fan (1)

# Step 1 — Bottom Cover





- Turn off the computer and unplug the charger before going any further.
- Flip the laptop over so you can see the underside.
- Remove the ten 7mm T5 Torx screws.

# Step 2





- Pry up the bottom cover with an opening tool.
  - Start at the front edge of the cover and make your way along the sides.

# Step 3



 Pull the bottom cover up and away from the back hinges.

#### Step 4 — Left Fan



- When the laptop is upside down, the left fan is on the right side of the laptop near the wireless card and the SSD.
- Remove the black and white antenna wires from the groove on the right side of the fan.


#### Step 5






- Disconnect the fan cable. Pull the wire toward the right side of the laptop while wiggling to loosen the connection.
  - You can also use the white tabs on the connector to push the cable free.

# Step 6





Remove two 4mm Phillips #1 screws.

# Step 7



 Pull the fan up and towards the front of the laptop.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
