

INTRODUCTION

This guide shows how to remove and replace the left blade on the Toro Walk Behind Mower 21199HD 2018.



TOOLS:

- Wheel Chocks (2)
- Impact Wrench (1)
- 5/8" Socket (1)



PARTS:

- Toro Blade-Rotary 116-6358-03 (1)
- Toro Adapter-Blade 120-5236 (1)
- Toro Bolt-Blade 125-2466 (1)

Step 1 — Disconnect the spark plug wire





- Refore you begin, ensure that the mower is powered down and cool to the touch.
- Grab the plastic housing at the end of the spark plug wire and pull firmly to disconnect it.

Step 2 — Chock the rear wheels



- Chock the rear wheels to prevent the mower from rolling during service.
- if the blades are extremely dirty, you can clean them using the washout fitting so the bolts on the underside of the blade guard are accessible.

Step 3 — Lift up the deflector



Lift up the plastic deflector.

Step 4 — Remove the grass bag



- While holding the deflector up and out of the way, lift the grass bag handle away from the mower to detach it.
- Remove the grass bag.

Step 5 — Tilt the mower on its side



- Tilt the mower onto its side so the blades are facing out.
 - (i) This may require two people.

Step 6 — Remove the blade bolt





- Use an impact driver with a 5/8-inch socket to remove the left blade bolt.
 - if necessary, brace the blade with a screwdriver or extension by placing it in the hole in the metal blade guard.

Step 7 — Remove the blade





- Remove the left blade.
- Mhen installing the new blade, ensure that it's in the correct orientation and direction.

Step 8 — Remove the blade key adapter





Remove the left blade key adapter.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
