



How to Apply a Screen Protector for iPhone11 Pro Max

Apply a screen protector without leaving bubbles on your iPhone11 Pro Max.

INTRODUCTION

This guide will guide you through how to apply a screen protector to the **iPhone11 Pro Max**.

You will need to buy a screen protector that matches your mobile phone model online. The tools you need for this guide are basically included when purchasing the screen protector.

You can choose **an ordinary screen protector** or **anti-peek screen** at the time of purchase. **The ordinary screen protector** only protects the mobile phone screen from breaking. **The anti-peek screen** can ensure that others can only see the black screen but not the content when looking at the phone screen from an oblique side.

Step 1 — How to Apply a Screen Protector for iPhone11 Pro Max



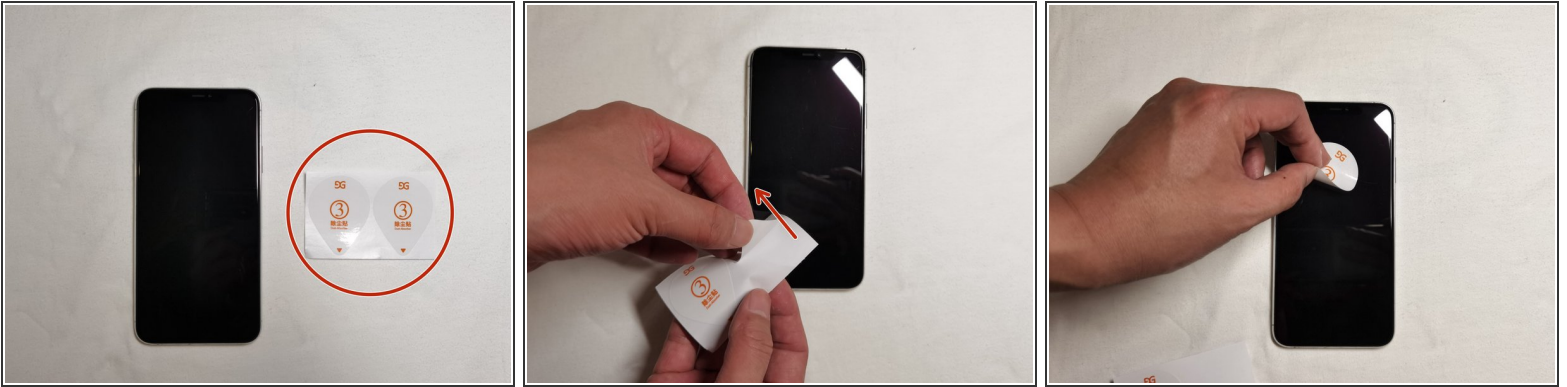
- Wipe the dust off the screen with a No. 1 alcohol cleaning wipe.
- ⓘ This will help to avoid bubbles when applying the screen protector.

Step 2



- Use a dry wipe to wipe off any water stains on the screen.

Step 3



- Tear off one of the dust removal tape strips.
- Use the dust removal tape to clean off the fine dust.

Step 4



- Put the auxiliary tool on your phone.
- Push down so that the auxiliary tool is firmly attached to the phone.
- i** This step is not necessary, and it doesn't matter if you don't have it. The auxiliary tool is just to assist you place the screen protector straight.

Step 5



- Take out the screen protector. Tear off the release layer of the screen protector (the thinner side).
- Aim the holes of the screen protector at the holes of the auxiliary tool and then slowly lay the screen protector onto the screen.

Step 6



- Wipe the screen surface around with a dry wipe to make the screen protector fit the phone screen better and lay flat.

Step 7



- Pull off the the auxiliary tool with your fingers.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
