Step 1 — Light Bulb



- Unplug the refrigerator.
- (i) Although it is optional, it ensures optimum safety when unplugged.

Step 2





- Carefully unscrew the lightbulb.
- Handle it safely with a dry cloth.

Step 3



• Clean the socket with a dry and clean cloth.

Step 4



- Screw-in the new lightbulb.
- Check to ensure it has been screwed in all the way.

Step 5





- Turn the light switch on.
- Close the refrigerator door and open it to check if the light bulb is now working.

The complete guide will mention that unplugging the refrigerator is optional however, it is recommended completing this step to ensure optimal safety.
