


Sega CD Plastic Housing Removal

This repair guide will take you through the process of removing the plastic Sega casing so to open up the console for further repair.

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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this replacement guide is to remove the Sega plastic casing to expose the internal content for further repair.



TOOLS:

- Spudger (1)
- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)


Step 1 — Sega CD Plastic Housing Removal





- Using a Phillips head screwdriver remove six screws from the bottom of the console.
 - The six screws are marked.

Step 2



- Remove the two screws that attach the Genesis' connector to the rest of the console.
 - The two screws are marked in the diagram.

Step 3




 Slide the lock tab to the left to separate the halves of the console.

Step 4




 Lift from the left side to remove the top of the case.

Step 5



 Using the spudger, pry the cover off of the Genesis attachment.

Step 6



 Lift the top of the case to remove the cover.

Step 7



 Remove the faceplate by pulling it up, then out.

To reassemble the device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
