INTRODUCTION

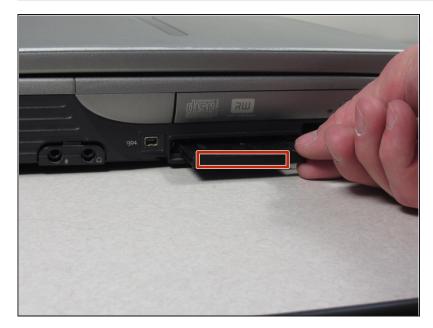
