


Samsung Galaxy Tab Pro 10.1 Rear Facing Camera Replacement

INTRODUCTION

This guide will show how to replace the rear facing camera on the Samsung Galaxy Tab Pro 10.1.



Step 1 — Rear Panel



- A Be gentle, the front panel is connected to sensitive wiring that may snap if too much pressure is applied.
- Insert a plastic opening tool into the crevice between the screen and the side of the tablet.
- Go around the entire crevice with the plastic opening tool.
- Set aside the separated front and rear panels of the device.

Step 2 — Rear Facing Camera



Use plastic tweezers and carefully detach the rear-facing camera from the motherboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
