INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how to:

- Remove the battery
- Remove the front panel
- Replace the speaker

TOOLS:

iFixit Opening Tool (1) T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery





- Hold the phone with the back facing you.
- Press the silver tab down and remove the cover.



 Pull up on the top edge of the battery to remove it.

Step 3 — Front Panel







• Use a plastic opening tool to gently pry the bottom cover loose.

⚠ Do not use excessive force at risk of damaging the antenna, which is under this casing.


Pull the cover from the front of the phone after the back is loose.





- Remove the two top screws with a T5 Torx screwdriver.
- (i) The screws are 8mm long.

Step 5






• Gently pry off the side casings from the top.

⚠ The side casings cannot be fully removed yet because they are screwed on at the bottom.

You will not need to remove the sides on the bottom.



- Use a plastic opening tool to detach the securing clips holding the the front panel in place.
- i There are six securing clips total.

Step 7



- Carefully remove the front panel.
- (i) You may need to apply some force in removing because the front panel is attached to the rest of the device with adhesive.

Step 8 — Speaker








- Use a T6 Torx screwdriver to remove the four screws located on the corners of the keyboard frame.
- (i) The screws are 6mm long.

Step 9





• After the bottom two screws have been removed the side casings can be removed.







- Remove the back case.
- i The speaker is located on the back case.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
