

Xbox One Wireless Controller Teardown

if you want to see the inside of your Xbox One Controller follow these steps

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TOOLS:

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- iFixit Opening Tool (1)
- TR8 Torx Security Screwdriver (1)
- T6 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Get an Xbox One Controller



 Start off with having an Xbox One Controller (:

Step 2 — Remove First Screw



• Start with removing the battery pack and exposing the T8 security screw. The screw should be hidden behind a warranty sticker.

Step 3 — Remove side panels



• Remove the side panels exposing the second T8 security screw using a spudger, an IFixit Opening Tool, or your nails, each choice is fun.

Step 4 — Remove all screws




• By removing all side panels all 5 T8 security screws have appeared!

Step 5 — Remove Faceplate



• Once you removed the T8 security screws remove the front face plate.

Step 6 — Tape down rumble motors




• Tape down the rumbler motors to prevent them from falling out.

Step 7 — Remove T6 screws



- Remove the T6 screws to remove the PCB's.
- It takes a pull to seperate the connectors.
- Watch the wires! You can not fully remove the circuit board without removing the wires and it requires soldering.

Step 8



- Remove the top cover, it folds over.
- There are 6 T6 screws to remove.

Step 9



- Remove the circuit board
- Under the rubber is the A B X Y buttons.

Step 10



• Follow the instructions in reverse to get everything together again. :D
