
#### **INTRODUCTION**

Trackpad not responsive or not working at all? Replace it (only screwdrivers required).

#### TOOLS:


T4 Torx Screwdriver (1)
Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
iFixit Opening Tool (1)

#### Step 1 — Track Pad



• Remove ten 3mm screws from the back cover with a **T5** screwdriver.


### Step 2






- Disconnect the ribbon cable with a plastic iFixit opening tool, by lifting up the black clip and by pulling the white ribbon off.
- Pull aside the ribbon cable.


### Step 3



 With a plastic iFixit opeing tool, insert it in between and remove the battery cable.


### Step 4






- Use a **PH00** size screwdriver to remove the 8 screws that secure the battery.
- Six 3mm screws.
- Two 5mm screws.
- Lift the battery out.


## Step 5



- Disconnect the ribbon cable with a plastic iFixit opening tool by lifting up the black clip and by pulling the white ribbon.
- Place aside.

## Step 6







- Remove four 2mm screws with a **PH00** screwdriver.
- Remove the mouse pad.
