### **INTRODUCTION**

The solid state drive replacement for the Acer Chromebook C740 requires removing the back panel and removing one screw. The solid sate drive stores data from the laptop.



# **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)



### **PARTS:**


 Acer Chromebook C740/C720/C720P SSD Drive (1)

### Step 1 — Back Panel



 Power down the Chromebook and disconnect the power adapter.

# Step 2





- Place the chromebook bottom side up on a flat surface.
- Remove the thirteen 7 mm screws with a Phillips #0 screwdriver.

# Step 3







- Insert the plastic opening tool into the slit near the hinges and pry upwards to lift the back panel.
  - (i) Applying pressure may be necessary. A click indicates the panel is ready to come off.


# Step 4 — Solid State Drive





• Remove the 3.75 mm screw with a Phillips #0 screwdriver.

Unplug the solid state drive.
