


Dell Inspiron 13-5368 Battery Replacement

A simple guide on how to remove and replace your Dell Inspiron 13-5368 Battery.

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INTRODUCTION

This is a simple step-by-step guide on how to remove and replace a battery for a Dell Inspiron 13-5368. You will need a Philips Head J-0 screwdriver and a pry tool in order to perform this task. It is very easy to do and will only take about 5 minutes.



TOOLS:


- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)



PARTS:


Dell WDX0R Replacement Battery (1)

Step 1 — Battery




Remove the nine 6mm Phillips #0 screws that secure the back cover of the laptop.

Step 2




Use a spudger to pry up and remove the back cover.

Step 3



 Remove the four 3mm Phillips #0 screws at the corners of the battery that secure it to the laptop.

Step 4



- Pull the battery cable's black tab towards the battery to disconnect it from the motherboard.
 - Pull the tab parallel to the motherboard, not straight up.

Step 5





Remove the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

For optimal performance, after completing this guide, <u>calibrate</u> your newly installed battery.

Take your e-waste to an R2 or e-Stewards certified recycler.
